# Faculty Enhancement Opportunity (FEO) Grants

If you are interested in applying, please read the information <u>http://com-faculty-affairs-a2.sites.medinfo.ufl.edu/2020/08/20/spring-</u> <u>2021-faculty-enhancement-opportunity-feo/</u>. Please <u>make sure you meet the eligibility requirements</u> before applying (Faculty must have been hired on or before October 18, 2017). This is an excellent faculty opportunity that is supported by the COM Faculty Council, Dean Tyndall, Dean Haley, Provost Glover and President Fuchs.

This is a 3 step process:

- The College of Medicine FEO (COM-FEO) review committee requires a brief Letter of Intent (LOI) to be summited as a oneline email sent to <u>hamleen@ufl.edu</u> to indicate that you will be preparing an application. The LOI must include: a) the date you joined the UF faculty; b) a description of the activity you will be requesting support for (1-2 sentences); c) an estimate of the total cost; and d) the time frame that the activity will take place (the activity must take place between January and June 2020). The electronic LOI is due by September 18, 2020 and the complete application is due by September 21, 2020 @5:00PM.
- 2. Your application will be reviewed by the COM-FEO review committee to determine which applications will be recommended for support. If needed, we may request clarifying information.
- 3. If supported by the COM-FEO review committee, your application will be submitted to the Provost on or before the University submission deadline of October 19, 2020, for consideration by the University committee.
