help folks get the help they need, or counsel them towards better behavior if appropriate.

- Works with Hospital Operations to include:

 - Emergency Department, critical care, hospitalists
 - Chairs the Capital Committee for the hospital
 - Works with administrators at Central Florida Health in The Villages and Leesburg
- Bridges communication amongst faculty, and between faculty and the institution
- Works with the hospital's Chief Quality Officer regarding ethics, infection control, and safety metrics.
- Works on clinical program development.
- Serves as a mentor/mentee.
- Directs inter-relationships between Jacksonville, Halifax, Deltona, Central Florida Health and Jupiter Health.
- Serves as a Board Member for the Rehab and Long-term Acute Care hospitals
- Dr. Gibbs will likely begin attending the COM Faculty Council meetings on a quarterly basis to provide hospital operations updates.
