Minutes:

- 1. The meeting was called to order at 5:00pm.
- 2. The minutes from the November 7th, 2023 meeting were approved.
- 3. Updates on appointment of Interim Dean for COM David Nelson, M.D., Senior Vice President for Health Affairs, UF & President, UF Health
 - Dr. Nelson discussed the upcoming appointment of the Interim Dean for the College of Medicine. He stated that the two options before launching a national search for Dean are to either appoint a short-term Interim Dean for 4 to 6 months who would continue the activities that are currently underway or to appoint a Dean for a 1 to 2-year term. Dr. Nelson met with President Sasse and the Board of Trustees and provided them with a list of names who would fulfill those pathways and who are active Department Chairs that are deeply involved in the college. President Sasse has interviewed three candidates within the last two weeks. Dr. Nelson recently met with the College Leadership Council to get their input and is meeting with the COM Faculty Council today.

to get their input. He will then make a recommendation to President Sasse and their decision should be announced within a couple of weeks.

- Dr. Nelson also met with all of the COM Department Chairs to go through the transition plan.
 He asked for a detailed document outlining their priorities for the next 3-4 months, which he will
 share with the Interim Dean. He has also worked with the Senior Associate Deans to identify
 any immediate issues that need to be addressed.
- Dr. Nelson stated that he expects the future Dean to be a strong academic phenotype because he feels that is the direction the college is headed. He stated that the Interim Dean needs to be someone who has credibility, respectability, can work with the other Department Chairs, and is a Department Chair with a current or recent leadership skillset.
- Dr. Nelson asked the Faculty Council members what unique skill sets or needs they would like to see in the Interim Dean. The following opinions were shared:
 - o The individual should uphold the multi-mission and integrated health mission.
 - A strong collaborator and bridge-builder is needed to bring the college and the hospital together.
 - The incoming Interim Dean or Dean needs to be mindful to advertise all of the research done here, apart from the AI realm which is getting top billing now.
 - The incoming Interim Dean or Dean should have a strong financial sense, should be a good communicator and collaborator, and should be innovative to keep academics afloat.
