3. New Business:

- The current UF Faculty Senate Chair, Dr. Danaya Wright, recently emailed faculty regarding the new law about hiring people from the 7 countries of concern. The Board of Governors is working on understanding and interpreting the law. The following details were noted:
 - Current UF students are not impacted by the new law, and visits home by those students to any of the 7 countries is not an issue.
 - Undergraduates with citizenship from the 7 countries of concern currently living in the United States can be granted Teaching Assistantships (TA's) and Research Assistantships (RA's).
 - Undergraduates with citizenships from the 7 countries of concern currently living outside of those countries can get TA's and RA's.
 - Students with citizenship from any country currently living in the 7 countries of concern, as interpreted at this point, cannot get TA's or RA's.
 - Post-docs from these 7 countries can still be hired with an H1B Visa.
